

## Community health services in scope of the review

The community health services strategic review will include all NHS funded community services for adults and children and young people delivered by both NHS community and acute providers (outside of a hospital setting and not part of an acute hospital episode).

Also included in the review are community services funded by the NHS, but delivered by voluntary and community organisations, the independent sector and by primary care partners (but not part of the core primary care contract).
