

Mental health services in scope of the review

The NCL CCG mental health services strategic review will consider:

- All NHS funded mental health services for residents living in north central London – Barnet, Camden, Enfield, Haringey and Islington. This will include perinatal, children and young people, adults and older adults and people with a learning disability services, delivered by NHS and non-NHS service providers.
- Both inpatient and community services as well as mental health services delivered in acute hospitals and schools.

The following is a list of mental health services that will be considered as part of this review:
